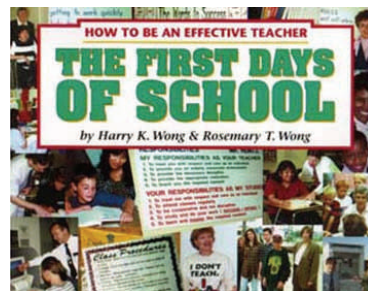

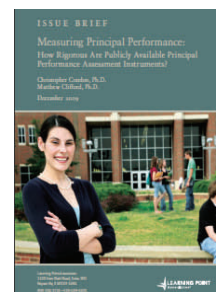


Nancy Sellers discusses what effective principals do to create a successful school culture for the teachers and students, based on his many years of consulting and research.
