


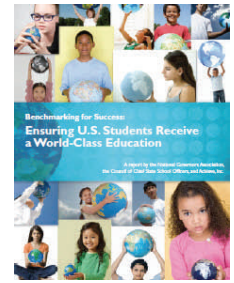


TRACK SEVEN: DISCUSSION POINTS
